"Auld Lang Syne" (Scots pronunciation: [ˈɔːl(d) lɑŋ ˈsəɪn]) is a Scottish song. In the English-speaking world, it is traditionally sung to **bid farewell to the old year** at the stroke of midnight on New Year's Eve/Hogmanay. The song reflects on old times and is an appropriate toast for the new year.
